1.0 Purpose

For the purposes of this Policy, Lindsay Australia/us/we shall mean Lindsay Australia Limited ABN 81 061 642 733 and its associated entities including but not limited to Lindsay Rural Pty Ltd ACN 090 821 300, Lindsay Transport Pty Ltd ACN 055 792 919, Lindsay Fresh Logistics ACN 600 103 242 and Lindsay Brothers Management Pty Ltd ACN 010 571 954.

3.0 Security of Information

3.1 Administration security
